What causes pharyngitis? It has been estimated that around 80% of the pharyngitis cases are due to viral infections. Rhinovirus is the main cause of viral pharyngitis causing sore throat. Over the counter, anti-inflammatory medications can help relieve pain but needs to be used minimally. Gargling with salt water would help tremendously and provide a soothing effect on the throat.

Pharyngitis is a type of upper respiratory tract infection. Most cases are caused by a viral infection. Strep throat, a bacterial infection, is the cause in about 25% of children and 10% of adults. Uncommon causes include other bacteria such as gonorrhea, fungus, irritants such as smoke, allergies, and gastroesophageal reflux disease.

If treating with an antibiotic, it is the consensus of the ICSI work group that penicillin (PCN) is the drug of choice for treatment of culture-positive cases of GAS pharyngitis. In children and patients unable to swallow pills, amoxicillin is an acceptable alternative due to the poor palatability of the penicillin suspension (Lennon, 2008).

While GAS is the most common bacterial cause of pharyngitis, acute pharyngitis is most commonly caused by viruses. 1 GAS is the causative organism in 20-30% of cases of pharyngitis, but can increase to 35-50% depending on the population and season. 2,3 Notably, the symptoms of viral and bacterial pharyngitis can be challenging to differentiate.

Pharyngitis is usually caused by the viruses that also cause a common cold or flu. In rare cases, the condition can be caused by bacteria. It is difficult to determine whether a case of pharyngitis has a viral or bacterial cause, since the symptoms are similar. Smoking, vaping and exposure to airborne irritants can also cause a sore throat.
