In order to run JBoss Application Server from the command line, add the `jboss-<release>\bin` directory to your path, for example: `C:\Program Files\JBoss\jboss-<release>\bin`. To do this, open the Control Panel from the Start Menu, switch to Classic View if necessary, open the System Control Panel applet, select the Advanced Tab, and click on the Environment Variables button.

### JBoss Application Server

Deploying an application in JBoss is simple and easy. You just have to copy the EAR file to the deploy directory in the 'server configuration' directory of your choice. Here, we will deploy it to the 'default' configuration, so we copy the EAR file to the `JBASS_DIST/jboss-as/server/default/deploy` directory.

### JBoss Application Server

Start your server. There is a bin directory within the JBoss Application Server or the JBoss ESB Server (whichever you have chosen to use). Execute the run script (`run.sh` on Linux/Mac OS X/Unix, `run.bat` on Windows). Verify the server you have chosen is running by visiting `http://localhost:8080` with your web browser.

The `standalone/deployments` directory in the JBoss Application Server 7 distribution is the location end users can place their deployment content (e.g. war, ear, jar, sar files) to have it automatically deployed into the server runtime.

Deploying on a running JBoss Web server. It is possible to deploy web applications to a running JBoss Web server. If the `Host autoDeploy` attribute is "true", the Host will attempt to deploy and update web applications dynamically, as needed, for example if a new .WAR is dropped into the `appBase`. For this to work, the Host needs to have background processing enabled which is the default configuration.

### JBoss Web - JBoss Web Web Application Deployment

The JBoss Application Server ships with three server configurations. You can choose which configuration to start by passing the `-c` parameter to the server startup script. For instance, command `run.sh -c all` would start the server in the all configuration. Each configuration is contained in a directory named `JBASS_HOME/server/[config name]/`. You can look into each server configuration's directory to see the default services, applications, and libraries supported in the configuration.

Downloading JBoss Web Server. Open a browser and log in to the Red Hat Customer Portal. Click Downloads. Click Red Hat JBoss Web Server in the Product Downloads list. Select the correct JBoss Web Server version from the Version drop-down menu.

The deployment scanner should not be used in conjunction with other deployment methods for application management. Applications removed from the application server by the management console will be removed from the runtime without affecting the marker files or application contained in the deployment directory.

For many use cases, the centralized management capability available via a managed domain is not necessary. For these use cases, a JBoss Application Server 7 instance can be run as a "standalone server". A standalone server instance is an independent process, much like an JBoss Application Server 3, 4, 5, or 6 instance is.
